1	Mandi/ Karsog	1	Katanda To Chowasi Garh	The Chowasi Garh area is situated at the top of Gram Panchayat Pokhi & Mahog in Development Block Karsog & the area has a good tourism potential. There is a temple of Chowasi Siddh Baba at Chowasi Garh. People from far and wide come here to see Siddh Baba. Hence, this place has a religious significance as well. Chowasi Garh can be reached from Thermi and Katanda by trekking route. The trek route starts near the Forest Rest House Katanda and passes through the village "Rokhlu" and Lotla forest. This place can be developed from the point of view of camping, on the way, you can see the beautiful apple gardens of the local peoples of nearby villages as well as rich Forest of Katanda Beat. The area experiences snowfall during winter months.
		2	Seri to Dhamoon	Dhamoon Tibba is located near Balidhar village of Karsog Sub Division situated at a distance of 28 KM from the Sub Divisional Headquarter. There is a heritage Temple of " Nag Dhamuni" on the ridge of Dhamoon Forest falling under the Seri Forest Range. The place can be reached from two mountain trek routes. The first route originates from Sianj Bagra which is about 5 km trek. Along this trek route, a place called Balidhar has a good potential for developing as a camping site. The second route is Seri to Dhamun via -Charog, which is about 8 km trek from Seri village. The Charog area falling enroute offers a good camping site. Whole of the trek route is surrounded by apple orchards & dense coniferous forests. The area experiences snowfall during winter months.
		3	Alsindi-Dhundun-Badyog	The ancient Temple of Dev Badyogi is situated at the ridge of Talehan Forest known as a Badyog Tibba. There are two mountain routes to reach here. One of the routes is Alsindi -Dhundun- Alyas-Badyog, which is about 8 km trek. Enroute this trek, a place called Soral offers a good camping site. The second trek route to reach Dev Badyogi temple is Jassal to Badyog, which is about 4 km trek from Jassal village of Churag Development Block.
		4	Khaniuli to Shikari Devi	This trek route leads to the famous ancient Shikari Mata temple situated at the top of Shikari Devi W.L. Sanctuary. The temple can be reached from Khaniuli area of Mashogal Gram Panchyat of Karsog Sub Division. There is a motorable road of 12 KM from Forest Check Post situated at Karsog-Mandi road at "Jacch" to Khaniuli. This trek route has not yet been explored from tourism point of view & has excellent potential for development from Ecotourism aspect. Whole of the trek route is surrounded by lush green Deodar forests and meadows. The trek from Khaniuli to Shikari Devi is about 11 Kms in length.
		5	Bakhrot - Shiva Dehra to Shikari Mata	This trek starts from Bakhrot village which is situated at Karsog- Shimla road and is 12 Kms from Karsog. There is a temple of famous deity "Dev Mahasu" at Shiva Dehra. People from surrounding villages visit the temple on Saji (First day of month in Hindu Calander). The trek further leads to Shikari Mata Temple & it joins the Karsog - Shikari Mata Road after a trek of 06 KM from Shiva Dehra. This place is surrounded by lush green forests, pastures and apple orchards. The trek from Bakhrot to Shivadehra & further upto Shikari Mata Road is about 13 Kms.

2	Mandi / Nachan	6	Panjain-Chunjwala	The trekking route constructed under scheme NRNM to influence tourist or tourism activities. It starts from camping site Panjain and ends at Devta Chunjwala temple. In the trekking route 5 nos resting/view point at different location are available. During trekking different panoramic views are shining and an ancient temple of Shri Chunjwal Devta at the end of trek
		7	Panjain-Khani-Khuhan	This trekking route is very old and in bad condition required to reconstruct.
		8	Sharti-Garl Shah- Matloda	This track route starts from Kothi of Sukh Dev Rishi situated at Sharti village of Saloi Beat. The

		13	Mayot to Devidarh	The trek from easy walks to challenging routes Mayot village is 9 KM far from Barot tourist place. There is motorable road from Mayot to Barot. The trek length from Mayot to Devidarh is about 5 KM. To start the trek one should reach first at Mayot then trek into the beautiful forest of Rai, Tosh and Kail species trees. This trek is maintained by forest department, however in the early days this trek was made by the King of Mandi Riyast to reach at Rajgundha a beautiful place. A temple named Mata Satbadli is situated at the nearby of Chaina Pass.
		14	Jharwar to Headgear	Embark on an extraordinary trek that leads you through a breath taking forest. Jharwar is a native village of Barot Village and 6 KM far from Barot. The trek is full of adventure and holy peace. To start from Jharwar village to headgear, our forest trek has something for everyone. Trek was made in British era. From Headgear there is a trolley line reach upto Zero Point that is discontinued now. One can enjoy the beauty of scodes, kayal, Rai, Tosh and their cool sheds that gives us peace of mind as well as body.
		15	Jhatingiri to Fulladhar	To start from Jhatingiri from NH 154 Ghatasni to Barot Road the trek starts its journey with moderate and moderate to steep path that gives challenges to the trek to finish the trail. This trek is approx. 3 Km and on the destination, you will find a forest rest house and trekker Hut Fulladhar. The site on the end point of trek will give you a pleasure and take away all your tiredness. You can enjoy the living of rest house or can have camping at the open place.
		16	Jhatingiri to Saragalu	If you are interested for short trekking, this route can give pleasure and satisfaction being a short trek for lovers. You can see the beauty of stunning deodar trees and the moderate path that is well maintained by the HP Forest Deptt. 5 KM far from NH 154 at Ghatasani to Jhatingiri village motorable road. Start from Jhatingiri to Saragalu, a beautiful site is near Jhatingiri where you can take rest and photography etc.
		17	Fulladhar to Winch camp	Phuladhar meaning mountain of blossoms is a trekking trail in the Joginder Nagar valley of Mandi district and in fact, one of those off beat treks at 8500 feet above the sea level that gives you the glimpse of two valleys at the same time- Joginder Nagar & Barot valley. The valley has a spread of thick deodar jungles and Rhododendrons all around. The region also goes by the name 360- named by the paragliding community in recent years, for obvious reasons. For most part of the trek, there are no roads, no shops and no electricity around, just the pristine Mountains.
		18	Fulladhar to Mayot	The trek from easy walks to challenging routes Mayot village is 9 KM far from Barot tourist place. There is motorable road from Mayot to Barot. The trek length from Fulladhar to Mayot is about 15 KM. To start the trek one should reach first at Jhatingiri then trek into the beautiful forest of Rai, Tosh and Kail species trees. This trek is maintained by forest department.

3 Mandi/ JNR

19	Bridge Mandi- Winch Camp	A unique and fascinating tourist destination located in HP near famous tourist destination Bir Billing. Experience a journey back in time as you ride on trolleys that were procured in 1932 for the Shanan Hydroelectric Power Project and are still in operation today.
20	Winch Camp- Chaina Pass	It is a very adventurous trek starts from billing to Chaina pass about 6-7 KM in distance. Enroute FRH Devidarh offers serene peace for stay. The trek passes through meadow and forests of deodar.
21	Fegru-Surajgarh	Connect with nature, passes thorough Oak trees, wooden elephants, waterfalls, orange-ish sunset, green meadows, local culture, traitional houses before finally arriving at your destination.
22	Patt-Devidarh	Take in the breathtaking views of the sunrise in the morning is famous Dividarh rest ouse offers site for short stay. As it is on top mommanding height whole valley is visible from this spot.
23	Dul- Wijnaiik	Go for a sightseeing session and capture stunning photographs of the natural beautiy and cultural highlights offers opportunity for bird watching passes through meadow forests.
24	Silh Budhani Rest house to Bhu-bhu pass and then to Karaun Kullu	Bhu-Bhu Jot is situated in the secondary axis of Dhauladhar mounatin range. It is an old historic trekking route used during the times of British era. That time it connects the kullu State (district) from Mandi state (district). It was mostly used during summer time. during winter It remain closed due to heavy snowfall. It was the shortest way that time to reach Kangra state. Merchents used this route to carry their goods from Kangra to Mandi to Kullu. When this route was closed during winter the alternate route was used through Dulchi Pass. This route has historic importance. On the way trekkers has to go through different type of forests which refresh the mind of trekkers.
25	Thaltukhod to Fungan Pass (Nargu Top)	It is a beacutiful trekking route full of picturesque views. Fungan pass is the abode of Local Deity Mata Fungani. Which is considered as the sacred place for both the Mandi and Kullu District people baccuse Mata Fungani is worshiped in both the district. At top there is a beautiful sacred Lake of Ma Fungani which is locally called Fungan Sar. At about 30 minute distance on foot the Highest peak (Nargu Top) of Nargu Wildlife Sanctuary is also situated. During the Month of Bahado 20 many locals and nearby trekkers trek via this route to Diana-sar Lake also.
26	Tikkan to Katyan Dhar	Tikkan is Range Head Quarter of Tikkan Forest Range. An adventurous Hiking trail through dense mix forest (of oak pines, rhododendron)leads from here to the place called Katyan Dhar. Katyan Dhar is situated in Tikkan beat of Tikkan Forest range. This place has good potential of paragliding take off site. It can also be a good camping site. It has mavelous view of Nargu top, Hathipur Dhar, Mahajani Tibba, Ghoghar Dhar, Phula Dhar, the distant mountain of Prashar Rishi and Kamru Nag. This area consists private land of many nearby villages therefore any development of ecotourism activity will uplipt all the stake holders here. It will directly indirectly provide the employment to local people.

7	Nahan/ Sri Renuka Ji	48	Haripurdhar- Mata Bhangayani Devi Trekking Route	Haripurdhar is situated in Sangrah Tehsil of District Sirmour (HP). Haripurdhar is 86kms away from Nahan town district headquarter and 59 km from Sri Renuka Ji a Ramsar site and famous religious site of north India. After arriving at Haripurdhar that there is approximately 3km upside trek route from haripurdhar main market to historic Kila peak , highest peak of the area having a Forest Guest House for facilitating visitors and a eye catching statue of Lord Shiva. After witnessing the lush green forests of Oak, Deodar, Fur and Spruce along with snow covered mountains of Kedar Nath range of the Himalaya in the far east and the Churdhar holy peak in north west one can restart his trek from Killa to the one of the very famous Devi Temple (jeepable road) of Himachal Pradesh Devi Maa Bhangayani only one km away .
		49	Awat to Chandpurdhar	Proposed Trekking route of approx. 4 Kms from Avat Village to Chandpurdhar Temple in Shillai Tehsil of Sirmour District. The Place situates nearly 71 KM from Paonta City of Sirmour District.
8	Nahan	50	Banethi To Jamta	Natural Legacy : IT is bestowed with magical scenic beauty, drifting clouds in mesmerising sky. Open valley view ending in Plains of Haryana at one side and snowy mountains at other side .It is the trail through verdant Evergreen forest of chilpine green ground cover with rich avian biodiversity and intermittent spotting of wild herbivores. 11	Chamba / Chamba	59	Namasi Dhar Trek	Situated at an altitude of 2456 M is a temple of deity Namasi at high meadow called as Namasi Dhar in Chamba Himachal Pradesh. The deity accepts no flesh sacrifice, hence the name Namasi is attributed to the same. The hike is completely uphill which make it a bit challenging. Although hike to Namasi Dhar can also be finished in one day provided with a good physical fitness. This trek is Shrouded by a green blanket of Pine and Deodar trees and enfolding refreshing water streams, the picturesque Nawasi Dhar Trek has always been one the most favorite spots of tourists in Upper Chamba Forest Range (DIstrict Chamba) nice picnic spot. There are many impresive waterfalls at Chadi Valley which is nearby Nawasi Dhar Trek.
		60	Lamdal Trek	Lamdal Lake Trek – A trek of seven sacred lakes. It is one of the most beautiful treks in the Dhauladhar range. A delight for trekkers, both in summer and monsoon, this is accessible through Brehi village – known for its rich variety of flora and fauna. The trail through alpine meadows, moraine ridges, glacier basins, conifer forests and ancient villages, gives you spectacular valley views and a chance to experience the wonderful slow-paced local lifestyle. There are 6 sacred lakes on the way to Lamdal lake which is the most scenic and biggest lake. Darkund Pass trek route lets travelers enjoy the mesmerizing beauty of innumerable streams, green landscapes, dense jungles along with rich flora and fauna culture and gather some ever-lasting memories from a great trekking experience. This lake's beauty beats even Chandratol and Brighu lake.

This trek takes you across snow carpets meadows and varied winter landscape eventually to a top with Epic panaromic view of surrounding snow capped peaks of Pabbar valley and himalyas Baspa range. The trek also takes you through a diverse flora of native plants and herbs. The Contrast ing colours of snowy trail and composite alongwith green shades of forest make it a Stunning trek. There are multiple approaches to Mural Danda top, but the trail from village Sharan is the most scenic and shortest.

Sareolsar lake :- Locals associates the lake with Diety Buddhi Naagin Goddess of snakes, Ghee and mother of all Naag Dieties and claims the lake's water possess medicinal properties. And a small temple to Buddhi Naagin overlooks the lake from its northside.

		105	Chanderkhani Trek	Chanderkhani Pass is a pass located in the Kullu District of India at a height of 3.660 metres. It forms a way between the villages of rumsu and Pulag to the well known village of Malana, which indirectly forms a trekking route from Naggar to Malana across the Chandekhani Pass.
		106	Rani-Sui Lake	The region is famous for its high altitude lakes, one being the stunning Rani Sui Lake. Also known as the Saurkundi trek, the lake lies in between the route to Bara Bhangal and Kalihani Pass and above the beautiful town of Manali. Rani Sui Lake is at an elevation of 11,154 ft. It is one of the very few high-altitude treks in the valley of Kullu. Many pretty wildflowers bloom on the vast pastures and surround the lake, making it appear no less than a paradise. It is a lesser-known trek of the region.

		108	Hamta Pass	The Natural landscapes and meadows, snowfall, trekking via Hamta pass to LahulSpiti, camping and hiking snowfall and valley view of Manali town are main attraction area.
		109	Bharigu Lake	It is named after Maharishi Bhrigu legend has it that the sage used to meditate near the lake and hence it has been rendered sacred the locals believe that due to this the lake never freezes completely. This lake is held sacred to the sage, Rishi Bhrigu, a great saint of India history

116	Neelkanth Mahadev Trek	The Trek to NeelkanthMahadev lake is one of the most untouched treks in Lahaul Spiti District of Himachal Pradesh. The best time for this trek is in the month of mid-July to end September. The nearest village from the trek basecamp is Nainghar and the total length of trek is 15 km on the way situated in pattan valley of Lahaul. The NeelkanthMahadev lake offers a splendid view of some of the tallest mountains in the region.
117	Manimahesh Trek	Manimahesh Trek viokugati is a high altitude trek that is graded as one of the toughest treks in HP. Gaddi tribe used this trekking route to cross over the two valleys which are Lahual and spiti. Kugati Pass trek is situated under the PirPanjal Range of the Himalaya.
118	Thanpattan	In this remote region of Lahaul, a valley filled with flowers hangs quietly, escaping the attention of trekkers. The route to this valley alternates between remote mountain valleys, quaint villages, and flower beds dominated by the overwhelming presence of Himalayan orchids. This valley is Miyar Valley.At the snout of the glacier are seven crystal clear blue ponds, considered to be sacred by Buddhists. Trekking here is a rare opportunity for most trekkers. And doing so in isolation, with very few others on the trail is a godsend. If you get a chance to trek to Miyar Valley, consider yourself lucky.
119	Miyar Glacier	The S-shaped Miyar Valley sits in between Zanskar and Chamba. It is nearly 75 km long. The Miyar glacier is nearly 36 km long to Kang La (17,600 ft pass to Zanskar).
120	Gurdhar Pass	This pass connects Miyar valley with ChasakBhatori of SechuNallah, Pangi. Locals & Migratory Shepherds from Chamba&Kangra used to cross these passes in early nineties.
121	Urgus la	This pass connects Miyar valley with Hilltuwan of SechuNallah, Pangi. Locals & Migratory Shepherds from Chamba&Kangra used to cross these passes in early nineties.
122	Hadsar	Hadsar is a tiny village with 3-4 households inside Tentu forest in jurisdiction of Tindi range. It is also known as a tourist destination because of its beautiful Landscapes, Alpine pastures and abundance of Wildlife; such as Himalayan Brown Bear, Himalayan Ibexes and it is also a home of one of the most elusive cat species, Snow Leopard.
123	Saptdhara Lake	Satdhara Lake is located about 7 kilometers away from the village of Hinesh. It is a religious place famous for the royal bath of Lord Triloknath. Here, on the first day of Pori Mela, Lord Triloknath and hundreds of people go to take bath. This is also a very famous area from the tourism point of view.
124	Kali Chho Pass	Located at an altitude of 4990 m in Bharmaur, Kalicho Pass lies on the PirPanjal Range. It is bounded by Miyar Nala in the Chenab Valley and Lahaul. Also, near to the pass is the Ravi Valley.

		125	Chhobiya Pass	Chobia Pass is the second highest pass in the Pir- Panjal mountain range, an interesting and adventurous trek of 5-6 days over one of the toughest treks. In this trek, tracker can view the beauty of Pir- Panjal range The Gaddies (shepherds) after spending six months in lower reaches of Kangra and Una District of Himachal Pradesh come to Bharmour, and move towards Lahul and Spiti through Kugti and Chobia passes to graze their flocks.
